WIS 32 Stage 2 Scheduled to Begin

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with reconstructing WIS 32 (Douglas Avenue). The project extends from just north of WIS 31 to just south of 5 Mile Road, and is scheduled to be complete late fall 2019.

As part of the reconstruction project, the upcoming work is scheduled for stage two:

Beginning Monday, August 5:

WIS 32 (Douglas Avenue), between WIS 31 and just south of 5 Mile Road, is scheduled to close long-term by 5:30 a.m.

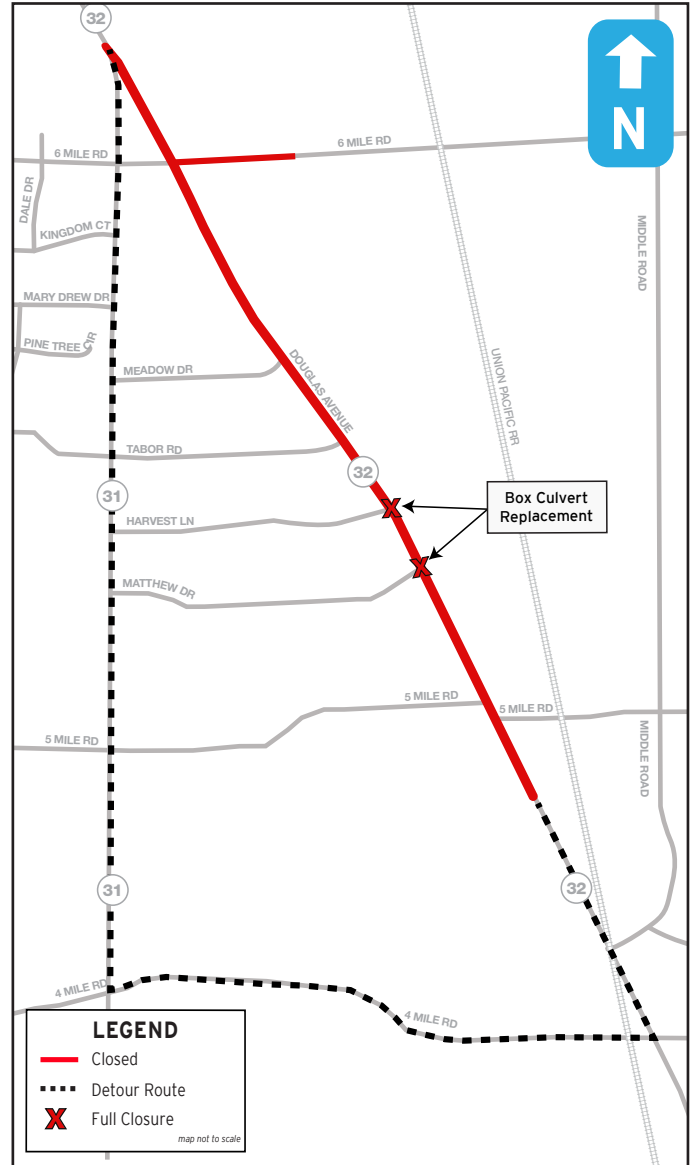
- Due to the box culvert work, access will be restricted to WIS 32 from Harvest Lane and Matthew Drive.
- Residential access will only be available from WIS 31 or Middle Road. Traffic for local businesses will be maintained throughout the closure.

Detour Route:

- Travelers can use WIS 31, and 4 Mile Road to get around the WIS 32 (Douglas Avenue) closure.

Other work will include:

- Traffic signal at WIS 32 and 6 Mile Road to be replaced.
- A new traffic signal installed at WIS 31 and WIS 32.



Please note that all closures are weather dependent and subject to change.
