Seven Mile Road, Under I-94, to Close Short-Term

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with reconstructing the I-94 North-South Freeway. The following work is scheduled for the next phase of this project.

Sunday, November 3:

 Seven Mile Road, between the I-94 EAST (SB) entrance/exit ramps and East Frontage Road, is scheduled to close overnight, as crews work to pour the I-94 WEST (NB) bridge deck over Seven Mile Road, install storm sewer, and begin patchwork. The roadway will reopen by Thursday, November 7 at 5 a.m.

Detour route: Motorists are encouraged to use County G, Ryan Road, 27th Street, the frontage roads, and WIS 38 to get around the Seven Mile Road closure.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.


