

Seven Mile Road Interchange to Close Long-Term

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with reconstructing the I-94 North-South Freeway. The following work is scheduled for the next phase of this project.

The following closures are scheduled to begin overnight Sunday, April 5:

- Seven Mile Road, between the frontage roads, is scheduled to close for approximately one month as crews work to reconstruct the roadway.
- I-94 entrance/exit ramps at Seven Mile Road are scheduled to close for approximately one month as crews work to reconstruct the ramp connections to/from Seven Mile Road.

Detour route: Motorists are encouraged to use the County G interchange and the frontage roads to get around the Seven Mile Road interchange closure.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
