

Ordinance No. 2023-01

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 10-1-13 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CALEDONIA, RACINE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, RELATING TO WINTER PARKING

The Village Board of the Village of Caledonia, Racine County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:


1. That Section 10-1-13 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Caledonia be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

- “(a) This Section shall be in effect through the winter months, from December 1st through April 1st, inclusive. The purpose of this Section is to assist the Village in keeping the streets free from snow and ice.
- (b) Parking of any vehicle between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. shall only be permitted on the even side of the street on even-numbered calendar days, and on the odd side of the street on odd-numbered calendar days.
- (c) For the purpose of public safety, property owners who live where turnaround tees exist are prohibited from parking any type of recreational or motorized vehicles within this area from December 1st through April 1st inclusive.”

2. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as provided by law.

The Village Board of the Village of Caledonia, Racine County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

1. That Section 10-1-13 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Caledonia be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

“(a) This Section shall be in effect through the winter months, from December 1st through April 1st, inclusive. The purpose of this Section is to assist the Village in keeping the streets free from snow and ice.

Deleted: Town

(b) Parking of any vehicle between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. shall only be permitted on the even side of the street on even-numbered calendar days, and on the odd side of the street on odd-numbered calendar days.

Deleted: the following day

(c) For the purpose of public safety, property owners who live where turnaround tees exist are prohibited from parking any type of recreational or motorized vehicles within this area from December 1st through April 1st inclusive.”

2. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as provided by law.
