PROPOSED LAND USE MAP AMENDMENT AND REZONING PROPOSED DATACENTER DEVELOPMENT

A drop-in session will be held to share information regarding the request for a Land Use Map Amendment and Rezone. The requested changes would amend land use designations from Agriculture, Rural Residential, and Open Land to Transitional Light Industrial for 245 acres along Botting Road and Douglas Avenue and rezone the parcels from A-2 (General Farming & Residential District II) to M-1 (Light Industrial and Office District).

The proposed project includes the future development of a data center—a secure facility housing large-scale servers and data processing equipment, typically generating modest traffic but requiring infrastructure like power, cooling, and stormwater systems.

Meeting Purpose: This is a drop-in session to share details about the entitlement process, gather community input, and answer questions. The applicant/developer will be present to address questions about the future data center development. No formal action or decisions will be taken at this meeting.
