

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-02

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SUBSECTION 10-1-26(D)(2) OF THE
CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CALEDONIA
PERTAINING TO PARKING FINES**

The Village Board of the Village of Caledonia, Racine County, Wisconsin, ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, current Village ordinance provides that the fine range for local parking violations must be at least \$5, but no more than \$50; and,

WHEREAS, the Village’s municipal court judge and the Village prosecutor have recommended that the fine range for Village parking ordinances violations should be broadened so as to allow a greater degree of flexibility with respect to stipulated resolutions to municipal court cases;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Board for the Village of Caledonia, that:

1. Subsection 10-1-26(d)(2) of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Caledonia be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

“(2) Forfeitures for Village Parking Offenses. The forfeiture for violation of Village parking regulations in this Chapter and for violations of Sections 346.50 through 346.55, Wis. Stats., adopted by reference in Section 10-1-1 of this Chapter shall be not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00)”

2. That this ordinance shall take effect upon the day after posting or publication in accordance with ordinance and applicable law.
