

Ordinance No. 2019-08

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE SECTION 2-3-19(C)(5) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CALEDONIA PERTAINING TO COMMITTEES OF THE VILLAGE BOARD AND COMMITTEE OPERATIONS

The Village Board of the Village of Caledonia do ordain as follows:

1. That Section 2-3-19(c)(5) of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Caledonia

be, and hereby is, created to read as follows:

"(5) If an appointed member of a committee will be absent, the committee member may designate an alternate member of the Village Board to attend one or more committee meetings on his or her behalf so that the committee meeting can proceed as scheduled. In the absence of a designation of an alternate member, the Village President may act under subsection (4) above or may designate a member of the Village Board to act as an alternate for the appointed member for one or more meetings during an absence of the appointed member. Any alternates designated hereunder shall be counted for purposes of determining a quorum and shall have the same powers to vote on all matters that may come before the committee."

2. That this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as provided by law.

Notice of Newly Enacted Ordinance

Please take notice that on June 3, 2019, the Village Board of the Village of Caledonia enacted Ordinance No. 2019-07 an Ordinance to Amend Section 7-6-1 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Caledonia pertaining to Regulation of Fireworks. Section 7-6-1 was amended primarily to add (d) (1) Vendor Sales of Novelty Items as follows: No person may sell or possess with intent to sell novelty items such as (a)(5), (a)(6), (a)(9) through (a)(14) as defined in the ordinance without first obtaining a conditional use permit as provided for under the Village's Zoning Code and a novelty items sales permit from the Village Clerk subject to certain conditions and requirements as set forth in the ordinance and payment of a permit fee. Sales will only be allowed on a temporary basis as may be approved under the conditional use permit with a duration of less than four (4) months. All vendor sales shall be subject to inspection at any time by the Village's Fire Chief and subject to any conditions and requirements imposed by the Village's Fire Chief.
