**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF CALEDONIA TO AWARD
A CONTRACT FOR THE WIND POINT SANITARY SEWER
REHABILITATION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Caledonia Utility District has identified the project area for a sanitary sewer rehabilitation project to reduce the amount of Infiltration and Inflow (I & I) into the sanitary sewer collection system; and

WHEREAS, the Caledonia Utility District has identified the project area for a sanitary sewer rehabilitation project due to age of the system, and type of pipe material; and

WHEREAS, the Caledonia Utility District has advertised to receive sealed bids for the Wind Point Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project and 3 sealed bids were received on August 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Caledonia Utility District, held a Public Bid Opening at the Utility District Offices and read the 3 sealed bids; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder was Visu-Sewer, Inc. W230 N4855 Betker Road Pewaukee, WI 53072, in the amount of \$1,468,354.27; and

WHEREAS, The Utility Director and the Utility District's consulting engineer, Foth Infrastructure & Environment LLC., recommended awarding the contract for the Wind Point Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project to the lowest responsible bidder, Visu-Sewer, Inc. in the amount of \$1,468,354.27; and

WHEREAS, The Utility District has recommended to awarding the contract for the Wind Point Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project to the lowest responsible bidder, Visu-Sewer, Inc. in the amount of \$1,468,354.27 at their August 30, 2018 Regular Business Meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the contract for the Project be, and hereby is, awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, Visu-Sewer, Inc. in the amount of \$1,468,354.27, and that the Village President and Village Clerk are authorized to execute any documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
