## **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-16**

## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF CALEDONIA TO PURCHASE BODY CAMERAS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board allocated \$70,000 in the Capital Projects Fund of the 2020 Budget for police worn body cameras and storage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department tested equipment from Digital Ally, Axon, Motorola and Watch Guard. Upon completion of testing, the Motorola SI500 was found to be the preferred body camera system to meet the needs of the police department.

WHEREAS, the Police Department received a quote from Motorola for the SI500 body camera system with data storage in the amount of \$77,825.58 for the first year, and \$18,942.00 for data storage each year for the next four years.

WHEREAS, the Police Department currently does not have body cameras and they believe that it is in the best interests of public safety and the Village to equip officers with body cameras.

WHEREAS, adequate there are funds available in the capital account to fund this purchase.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Caledonia Village Board that the purchase of the Motorola SI500 Body Camera System as described above at a cost of \$77,825.58 is authorized and approved and that the required funds shall be taken from the 2020 Capital Project Fund.
