

Park Descriptions/Reservation Rules and Regulations

Crawford Park

This 17.9 acre park opened to the public in August of 2002 and achieved the 2003 Park Design Award of Merit from the Wisconsin Park and Recreation Association Park Section. It is located behind the Greentree Mall at 5051 Chester Lane. This park contains 2 ball diamonds, a neighborhood playground, a shelter that can accommodate 100 people, has electricity & running water, flushing toilets (when reserved), a concession stand shelter w/open toilets (when reserved), walking trails, 2 tennis courts, 2 half court basketball courts, 2 sand volleyball courts, a parking lot, and open space.

Gorney Park

This 40 acre park is located on Nicholson Road just north of 7 Mile Road (8201 Nicholson Road). It has 2 ball diamonds, 2 playgrounds, 2 shelters with electricity, 2 soccer fields (1 full size, 1 practice field), walking trails, and a handicapped accessible fishing pier on a beautiful, fish-stocked pond which will make you want to come back for more fun.

Linwood Park

This 17.8 acre park is located on the Root River off of 5 Mile Road, east of Highway 38 (7305 – 5 Mile Road). It has a shelter (available for rent), 5 tables, benches, and access directly to the Root River. The Caledonia Historical Society has located the Old Town Hall and the Old Sturtevant Train Depot in this park.

Rules and Regulations for Shelter Rentals:

- A \$25 Refundable Escrow fee is required.
- To reserve a shelter, payment must be paid in full.
- Reservations are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Hours of use are from sunrise to sunset.
- Beer & Wine Permit may be issued at no additional fee.
- Must be 18 to rent a shelter unless a Beer & Wine Permit is requested, then the applicant must be 21 years of age.
- Renters reserve the shelter only and do not have exclusive rights to the playground equipment, or other areas of the park.
- Park shelters have electricity with the exception of Linwood Park.
- Reservation permits and any special permission letters must be available at the picnic. These permits must be available should Caledonia Police/Sheriff have a question.
- Glass is not permitted in any of Caledonia's parks.

- Open fires are not permitted in any park. All fires/cooking must be done in a grill.
- Clean-up and set-up is the responsibility of the renter. All trash must be placed in receptacles and the grounds and restrooms clean when the picnic is over. The renter will be held responsible for any damages and/or clean-up that are required after the event.
- Decorations are permitted but must be removed by the renter at the conclusion of the event.
 A charge will be assessed to the renter who made the reservation if Village staff has to remove decorations.
- Any materials or equipment belonging to the renter must be removed from the facility and grounds at the conclusion of the activity.
- Individuals or groups renting park facilities will be held responsible for the conduct of the people
 admitted to their activity. Parking is limited to posted areas. Please do not park on the grass at any
 time. A rental can be terminated immediately at the discretion of the department or the Caledonia
 Police for any violation of rules/regulations, any department policy, or any other Village or County
 ordinance violation.
- Parking is permitted in designated parking lots. Parking on the grass is not permitted.
- Crawford Park rentals include 2 parking passes to park next near the shelter using the service road off of Sunshine Lane. One of these passes is for handicap use only. There is no parking between the playground areas. All other vehicles attending your event must park in the main parking lot off Chester Lane and use the walking path to the shelter.

Please help us keep the parks safe and clean!

The Caledonia Parks and Recreation Commission requests your help in maintaining the beauty of the Caledonia area parks. Please report any vandalism, unsafe structures, public intoxication or questionable behavior as soon as possible to the Caledonia Police Department 886-2300. For an emergency dial 911.

- Keys are required to open the restroom at Crawford Park. Renters may pick them up at the Village Hall the Friday before the function. If these keys are not returned to the Village Hall after the function, the renter will lose their \$25 escrow.
- Renters may cancel a reservation 30 days prior to the function and receive a 50% refund.
- Cancellations are not accepted within 30 days of the function and no money is refunded.
- If the Village has to cancel the reservation, the renter will be issued a full refund or be offered another date in the future. (i.e. due to flooding, plumbing problems, etc.)
