

Upcoming short-term closure along WIS 38 in Racine County

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is notifying motorists of an upcoming short-term closure of WIS 38 in Racine County. On Monday, October 12, crews will begin replacement of a roadway structure that carries a small creek under STH 38, this is located between 4-Mile Road and Northwestern Avenue. Work is scheduled to be complete by the week of October 26. This schedule is weather dependent and is subject to change.

During the full closure of the roadway at the structure, motorists will be detoured along County Road G, WIS 31 and WIS 38 (Northwestern Avenue). Local access up to the structure will be maintained.
