Trustee Dobbs called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. in the Conference Room of the Village Hall, 5043 Chester Lane, Racine, Wisconsin.

Present were: Trustee Trentadue and Trustee Dobbs

Staff present: Village Engineer Tony Bunkelman and Village Administrator Tom Christensen

1. Approval of minutes

Motion by Trustee Trentadue to approve the minutes from the June 14, 2017 meeting. Seconded by Trustee Dobbs. Motion carried.

2. Historical Society Temporary No Parking request on 5 Mile Road for the Caledonia Historical Society Festival

The Historical Society has requested No Parking signs on 5 Mile Rd from Sept 8th through the 10th for their yearly festival. This is a busy event and in the past they have parked vehicles in the parking lot and grassy areas instead of attendees parking on the roadway.

Trustee Trentadue motioned to approve No Parking signs on 5 Mile Road during the event. Seconded by Trustee Dobbs. Motion carried.

3. 3 Mile Rd Reconstruction – Douglas Ave to LaSalle Street Project Update – Construction Year

Bunkelman has been in contact with John Rooney with the City of Racine in regards to the 3 Mile Road project. This will be a long process. The last project there was an intergovernmental agreement that spelled out who paid for what. In order to keep the project moving, he will continue to work with Rooney and get a Public Hearing in the City of Racine in 2018 and then there will be a projected construction date in 2019.

There has been conversation about removing the medians. There are right of way constraints and large utility poles which they do not want to move. Dobbs stated he was in favor of keeping the two lanes but also would not like to see stoplights or a 4 way stop.

Trustee Trentadue motioned to recommend the Village Board that the Village of Caledonia designate funding in 2019 for the 3 Mile Road Reconstruction Project with the City of Racine. Bunkelman will continue to work with the City of Racine and Christensen will explore funding. Seconded by Trustee Dobbs. Motion carried.

4. Adjournment

Motion by Trustee Trentadue to adjourn. Seconded by Trustee Dobbs. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 1:48 p.m.
