They track relevant demographic, development and other data and use it to inform communities. Grand Appliance is constructing a 137,000 sq. ft. headquarters and distribution facility in Sturtevant. Relocating 120 jobs, creation of 22 new jobs and \$7.2 million capital investment. Regency Mall TID creation to facilitate redevelopment in Regency Mall. Mertz North America in Grandview Business Park. Home to particle manufacturing, packaging professional services and distribution operations. Retain 165 existing positions and create 20 new positions over

the next 3 years. \$3 million capital investment. Willing requested information showing how many of the positions were newly created versus existing.
