- 5. From Martha Hutsick reporting on the Caledonia Douglas Avenue Business Association: Martha submitted a revised Flower Pot Program detailed in attachment

Martha reported the 2020 budget request form the CDABA to the CDA is as follows: Flowerpot Plant and Maintenance Program (CDA portion only) \$5,262.50 Motion made by Marla Wishau to allocate \$5,300.00 from the 2020 CDA budget for the CDABA's use. Seconded by Jeremy Hinds. Motion Carried.
