## <u>9C - Resolution 2019-100 – A Resolution Of The Village Board Of The Village Of</u> <u>Caledonia To Retain The Law Firm Of Phipps, Deacon, Purnell, PLLC, As Outside</u> <u>Counsel To Handle Opioid Related Claims Asserted By The Village In State Court</u>

Attorney Ekes updated the board. Trustee Martin felt that due to the many unknowns it would be premature to make a decision at this time. The board contemplated with if it would be worth the Police and Fire departments time to research their records for the necessary data. Trustee Weatherston was against it at this time and felt it would cost too much time and money. Trustee Wanggaard agreed. President Dobbs suggested laying it over.

Motion by Trustee Martin to lay over Resolution 2019-100 directing the Police Chief and Fire Chief put together a rough estimate of time spent on opioid related calls. Seconded by Trustee Prott. Motion carried unanimously.
