At the conclusion of the hearing, it is intended that the Board will convene in CLOSED SESSION pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes to deliberate concerning the quasi-judicial hearing regarding the appeal of Leslie Briesemeister for an exemption to the residency restrictions that would allow him to reside at (Willowgreen Home) 4719 Kingdom Court, and that the Board will RECONVENE IN OPEN SESSION to announce its decision and move to the remaining items on the agenda as posted.

To the extent that a quorum of another board, commission or committee actually attends this meeting, this meeting may be rebuttably presumed to be a "meeting" within the meaning of Wisconsin's open meeting law. Nevertheless, only this Sex Offenders Residency Board agenda will be discussed. No votes or other action will be taken by any separate board, commission or committee at this noticed meeting.
