ORDINANCE NO. 2024-03 VILLAGE OF CALEDONIA

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 7, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 1 RELATED TO CIGARETTE, TOBACCO, AND ELECTRONIC VAPING DEVICES LICENSING

The Village Board of the Village of Caledonia, Racine County, do ordain as follows:

1. That Section 7-3-1 of the code of ordinances for the Village of Caledonia "Cigarette License" be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 7-3-1 CIGARETTE, TOBACCO, AND ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES LICENSE.

- (a) Definitions.
 - (1) "Cigarette" means any roll of tobacco wrapped in paper or any substance other than tobacco.
 - (2) "Cigarette products" means cigarette paper, cigarette wrappers, or any substitutes.
 - "Electronic vaping device" means a device that may be used to deliver any aerosolized or vaporized liquid or other substance for inhalation, regardless of whether the liquid or other substance contains nicotine, including an e-cigarette, e-cigar, e-pipe, vape pen, or e-hookah. "Electronic vaping device" includes a component, part, or accessory of the device, and includes a liquid or other substance that may be aerosolized or vaporized by such device, regardless of whether the liquid or other substance contains nicotine. "Electronic vaping device" does not include a battery or battery charger when sold separately. "Electronic vaping device" does not include drugs, devices, or combination products authorized for sale by the U.S. food and drug administration, as those terms are defined in the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.
 - (4) "Tobacco products" means cigars; cheroots; stogies; periques; granulated, plug cut, crimp cut, ready-rubbed and other smoking tobacco; snuff, including moist snuff; snuff flour; cavendish; plug and twist tobacco; fine cut and other chewing tobaccos; shorts; refuse scraps, clippings, cuttings and sweepings of tobacco and other kinds and forms of tobacco prepared in such manner as to be suitable for chewing or smoking in a pipe or otherwise, or both for chewing and smoking.
- (b) **License Required.** No person shall, in any manner, directly or indirectly, upon any premises, or by any device, sell, exchange, barter, dispose of, give away, or keep for sale, any cigarettes and cigarette products, tobacco products, and electronic vaping devices without first obtaining a license.
- (c) Application for License; Fee. Every person applying for a license under this section shall file a written application with the Village Clerk stating the name of the applicant and the name and address of the premise for which the license is requested. The applicant shall pay a license fee in an amount set by resolution of the Village Board from time to time.
- (d) **Issuance and Term of License.** A license under this Section will be issued by the Village Clerk unless the Clerk refers the application to the Village Board for denial or

- non-renewal as set forth in Section 7-3-1(e). Each license will be issued on the first day of July in each year, or from the date approved, if after July 1, and shall continue in force from the date of issuance until the succeeding June 30th unless revoked or suspended for any violation of this section.
- (e) **Revocation, Suspension, or Denial of License.** Any license issued under this Section may be suspended or revoked for cause by the Village Board after notice to the licensee and a hearing. Any application for a license under this Section be denied or non-renewed for cause by the Village Board after notice to the licensee and a hearing. "Cause" shall include, but is not limited to, the sale of illegal products such as products containing THC or other drugs, or other violations as set for in Wis. Stat. § 134.65(7). Notice and hearing on revocation, suspension, denial or non-reviewal shall be conducted in accordance with Wis. Stat. 134.65 (6)-(7).
- (f) Penalty.
 - (1) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$500 and, in default thereof, may be imprisoned as provided by law.
 - (2) Citations may be issued for all violations of this section with or without prior notice. The stipulation, forfeiture and court appearance amounts set forth in Section 1-1-6 shall apply to this Section.
- (g) **Statutory Provisions.** The provisions of Wis. Stats. §§ 134.65 and 134.66 and Chapter 139, regulating the use of tobacco products shall be adopted in this section."
- 2. That this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-04 VILLAGE OF CALEDONIA

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 7, CHAPTER 1, SECTIONS 1 AND 6 RELATED TO DOGS AND FARM ANIMALS AT LARGE.

The Village Board of the Village of Caledonia, Racine County, do ordain as follows:

- 1. That Section 7-1-1(b) of the code of ordinances for the Village of Caledonia "DOG LICENSES REQUIRED; DEFINITIONS; ADOPTION OF STATUTES" be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:
- "(b) **Definitions**. In this Chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise require:
 - (1) "Owner" shall mean any person owning, harboring, or keeping an animal and the occupant of any premises on which an animal remains or to which it customarily returns daily for a period of ten (10) days. An occupant of any premises on which an animal remains or to which it customarily returns daily for a period of ten (10) days is presumed to be harboring or keeping the animal within the meaning of this Section.
 - (2) "Dog at Large" means an dog that is off the premises of the owner and not under the control of some person by Leash or other control. A dog within an automobile or trailer of its owner, or in an automobile of any other person with the consent of the owner of said dog, shall not be an dog at Large.
 - (3) "Dog" shall mean any canine, regardless of age or sex.
 - (4) "Cat" shall mean any; feline, regardless of age or sex.
 - (5) "Neutered" as used herein as describing a dog or cat shall mean a dog or cat having nonfunctional reproductive organs.
 - (6) "Animal" means mammals, reptiles and birds that are owned by an individual. Wild animals are not under this definition in this Chapter.
 - (7) "Cruel" means causing unnecessary and excessive pain or suffering or unjustifiable injury or death.
 - (8) "Law Enforcement Officer" has that meaning as appears in Wis. Stat. Sec. 967.02(5), and includes a humane officer under Wis. Stat. Sec. 58.07, but does not include a conservation warden appointed under Wis. Stat. Sec. 23.10.
 - (9) "Farm Animal" means any warm-blooded animal normally raised on farms in the United States or any animal used for food or fiber, including but not limited to horses, cows, and sheep.
 - (10) "Pet" means an animal kept and treated as a pet.
 - (11) "Leash" means a cord, thong or chain not more than ten (10) feet in length by which an Animal is controlled by the person accompanying it.
 - (12) "Primary enclosure" means a barn, fence, or other structure that is structurally sound and maintained in good repair to protect an animal from injury, to contain an animal, and to keep predators out. A Primary Enclosure shall be constructed and maintained to include a portion for the animals to remain dry and clean; constructed and maintained so that the animals contained therein have convenient

- access to clean food and water; and the floors of the primary enclosures shall be constructed so as to protect an animal's feet and legs from injury.
- (13) "Farm Animal at Large" means a Farm Animal that is one of the following: (1) outside a Primary Enclosure; (2) not under the control of some person over the age of ten (10) by Leash or control. A Farm Animal within a trailer of its owner, or in a trailer of any other person with the consent of the owner of said Farm Animal, shall not be a Farm Animal at Large."
- 2. That Section 7-1-6(c) of the code of ordinances for the Village of Caledonia "RESTRICTIONS ON KEEPING OF DOGS, CATS, FOWL AND OTHER ANIMALS" be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:
- "(c) **Dogs at Large Prohibited.** It shall be unlawful for the owner or keeper of any dog to permit or suffer such dog to be at large, which shall mean that it is off the premises of its owner or keeper and upon any public street or alley, any school ground, any public park or upon any other public or private property without the permission of the owner of the property, provided, however, a dog shall not be deemed to be at large if:
 - (1) It is attached to a Leash, and the Leash is held by a person competent to govern it of at least ten (10) years of age and prevent it from annoying or worrying pedestrians or trespassing on private property or trespassing on public properly where dogs are forbidden; or
 - (2) It is properly restrained within a motor vehicle or trailer."
- 3. That Section 7-1-6(d) of the code of ordinances for the Village of Caledonia "RESTRICTIONS ON KEEPING OF DOGS, CATS, FOWL AND OTHER ANIMALS" be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:
- "(d) Farm Animal At Large. It shall be unlawful for the owner or keeper of any Farm Animal to permit or suffer a Farm Animal at Large, which shall mean whether on the owner's premises or not, that it is one of the following: (1) outside a Primary Enclosure; (2) not under the control of some person over the age of ten (10) by Leash or control. However, a Farm Animal shall not be deemed to be a Farm Animal at Large if it is properly restrained within a motor vehicle or trailer."
- 4. That Section 7-1-6(e) of the code of ordinances for the Village of Caledonia "RESTRICTIONS ON KEEPING OF DOGS, CATS, FOWL AND OTHER ANIMALS" be, and hereby is, created to read as follows:

"(e) Owner's Liability for Damages and Costs Caused by Animals at large; Penalties.

- (1) In the event the animal at large is a dog, the provisions of Wis. Stat. Sec. 174.02, relating to the owner's liability for damage caused by dogs together with the penalties therein set forth are hereby adopted and incorporated herein by reference.
- (2) In the event the animal at large is a Farm Animal, the owner is subject to a forfeitures as outlined in Sec. 7-1-30.

	(3)	The owner of any animal at-large and/or captured under this Section shall pay, in addition to all penalties outlined in this Section, all veterinarian fees, including but not limited to fees for shots, licensing, room and board, or other costs with collecting and holding an animal at-large."

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-053 VILLAGE OF CALEDONIA

A RESOLUTION APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 AND CHANGE ORDER NO. 2 ON THE CALEDONIA CORPORATE PARK INTERSECTION PROJECT

The Village Board for the Village of Caledonia, Racine County, WI do resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Village of Caledonia is contractually obligated in the Development Agreement with TI Investors of Caledonia LLC, which has been adopted by Resolution 2022-41, to construct the Intersections of the Public Roads with Highway K as a Village Project and as part of the Infrastructure Improvements of the Caledonia Corporate Park.

WHEREAS, the Village of Caledonia has designed the Caledonia Corporate Park Intersections Project within the Highway K Right of Way to provide access to the Caledonia Corporate Park property for development.

WHEREAS, the Village of Caledonia adopted Resolution 2023-36 which awarded the Caledonia Corporate Park Intersections Project to the lowest responsible bidder, Reesman's Excavating & Grading Inc. 28815 Bushnell Road Burlington, WI 53105, with a bid amount of \$1,220,287.99.

WHEREAS, during the construction of the Caledonia Corporate Park Intersections Project there were certain changes that were required.

WHEREAS, Change Order #1 is for a Concrete Pole Base Extension, a Mobilization Charge due to a delay in signal startup and a Pull Box drain which have an increase in cost of \$10,866.98 (0.89%).

WHEREAS, Change Order #2 is a miscellaneous quantities, balancing change order, which matches the as-built quantities and which has a decrease in cost of \$79,717.44 (6.53%, 5.64% Overall).

WHEREAS, the Public Services Director and the Village's consulting engineer (Foth) on the project, recommend approving Change Order #1 and Change Order #2 for the Caledonia Corporate Park Intersections Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village Board of the Village of Caledonia, that Change Order #1 and Change Order #2 for the Caledonia Corporate Park Intersections Project, are hereby approved and that the Public Services Director is authorized to execute the Change Orders as necessary for furtherance of the Project.

Dear Committee of the Whole:

The Caledonia Utility District recently had Pump #3 go down at the Riverbend Lift Station. This pump is an 8" Fairbanks B5415. The Utility had Pump #3 pulled and sent to L.W. Allen, the local distributor of Fairbanks Pumps. They tore down the pump and discovered that the Front Head and Volute were damaged, and that the impeller needed to be replaced. These are all major components to any pump. The quote to repair the existing pump was \$44,873. This price immediately brought up the potential for a new pump as a replacement. The current pump is 36 years old. The cost for a new pump is \$64,845.

Based on the cost of repair versus the cost of new, the Caledonia Utility District recommended at its April 3, 2024 meeting, that a new pump be purchased as the replacement.

The Fairbanks Nijhuis Pump is a sole source item because the Caledonia Utility District has all Fairbanks Nijhuis pumps within its current system. The staff is familiar with maintaining Fairbanks Nijhuis pumps and it would not make sense to introduce a different brand of pump into the system. The Fairbanks Nijhuis pumps have been reliable and dependable. The local distributer for Fairbank Nijhuis pumps is L.W. Allen of Madison.

The cost for this sole source item is as follows. For the Fairbanks Nijhuis pump the total cost is \$64,845.

The Caledonia Utility District is requesting to use the Sole Source Products/Specific Brands Exception in Ordinance 2-4-25(d)(3)(c)(ii) for the purchase of the Fairbanks Nijhuis Pump B5415.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Caledonia Utility District recently had 1 of the 8" pumps at Riverbend go out of service. The pump was removed and sent to LW Allen to provide a quote to repair the pump. On March 4th, a quote to repair the pump was received, along with a description of the repairs needed. The pump has a damaged volute, damaged front head, and a damaged impeller. The cost for a full rebuild of this pump to factory tolerances is \$44,873.00.

When this quote was received it was immediately asked what the cost of a new pump would be so that an analysis could be done. The cost for a new, identical pump would be \$64,845.00.

The typical service life for a lift station pump is 20 to 30 years. The pump is an original pump from when the station was built in 1988, so it has 36 years of service on it. To spend \$44,873 on this pump is difficult to do when spending an additional \$20,000 will get a new pump.

The lead time for a new pump is 13 weeks and the repair of the pump is anticipated at 11 weeks. With the lead time not being that much different it is still recommended that a new pump is purchased.

It is recommended that the Utility District purchase a new Fairbank 8" B5415 Pump for Riverbend Lift Station.

RECOMMENDATION

Move to forward to the Committee of the Whole to sole source purchase a Fairbanks 8" B5415 Pump for \$64,845.00 for the Riverbend Lift Station.
