**4 – New Business**

**A. Review and Discuss Angels Youth Softball Park Use Agreement for Crawford Park**

Staff presented a memorandum and summarized the Angels Youth Organization request to use Crawford Park for the second year in a row. Jeremy Holm, representing Angels Youth Softball Organization, spoke about the organization and that he has had a good relationship with Caledonia.

**B. Review and Discuss Gorney Dog Park History.**

Trustee McManus presented some history of a proposed Dog Park at Gorney Park in conjunction with Trustee Wishau and Trustee Martin.
